Our sentence bore, our ransom paid.

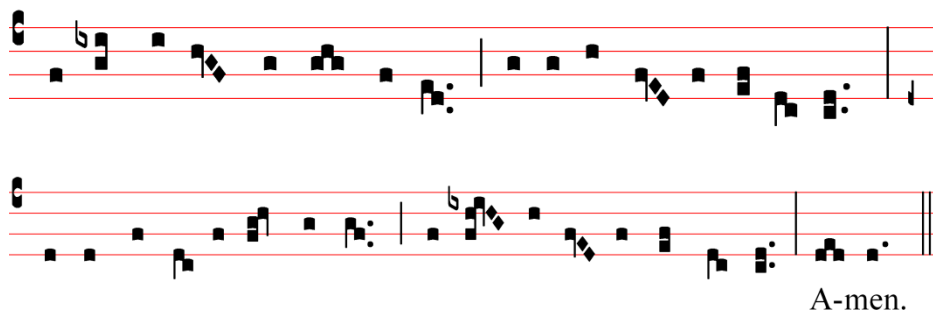
Where deep for us the spear was dyed,
