

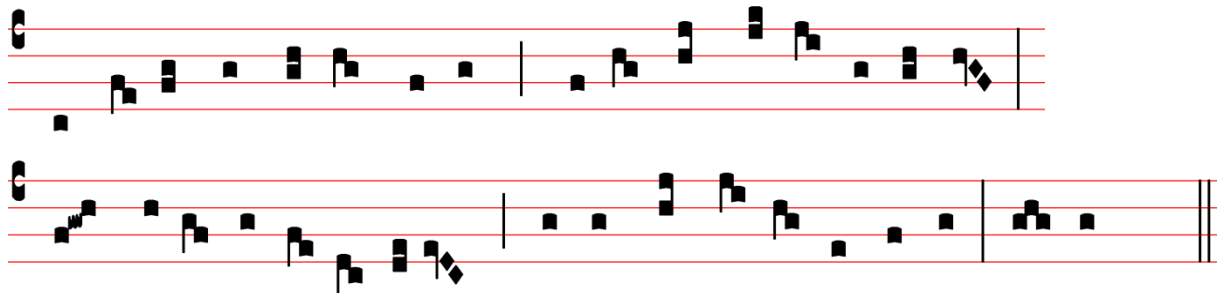
# Office Propers – 22<sup>nd</sup> June – S Alban
