

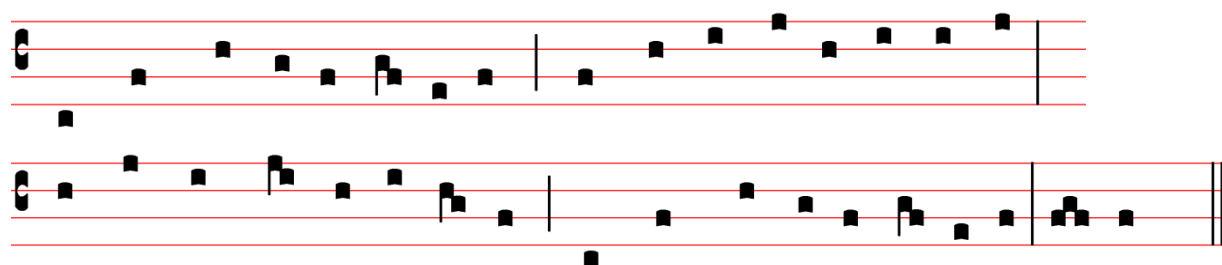
Office Propers – 9th June: S Columba
