
Office Propers – Saint Martin of Tours (11th November)

These are the proper texts for the Office on the feasts of Saints, which you should substitute for the seasonal texts provided in the booklet.

Venite Antiphon:

The Lord is glorious in His saints; O come, let us adore Him.

Office Hymn:



O Jesu, Saviour of mankind, In Whom the saints their glory find, On this commemoration day Hear Thou Thy people as they pray.

Contending for Thy holy Name, Thy servants won their saintly fame, Which Christian hearts with praise recall, And bless the Lord and God of all.

Psalm:

- (1) BLESSED is the man that hath not walked in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stood in the way of sinners: and hath not sat in the seat of the scornful.
- 2 But his delight is in the law of the Lord: and in his law will he exercise himself day and night.
- 3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the water-side: that will bring forth his fruit in due season.
- 4 His leaf also shall not wither: and look, whatsoever he doeth, it shall prosper.
- 5 As for the ungodly, it is not so with them: but they are like the chaff, which the wind scattereth away from the face of the earth.
- 6 Therefore the ungodly shall not be able to stand in the judgement : neither the sinners in the congregation of the righteous.
- 7 But the Lord knoweth the way of the righteous : and the way of the ungodly shall perish. Glory be to the Father and to the Son: and to the Holy Ghost.

Reading:

A Reading from the Gospel according to Saint Matthew.

Jesus said to His disciples, "When the Son of man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate them one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and he will place the sheep at his right hand, but the goats at the left. Then the King will say to those at his right hand, 'Come, O blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.' Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see thee hungry and feed thee, or thirsty and give thee drink? And when did we see thee a stranger and welcome thee, or naked and clothe thee? And when did we see thee sick or in prison and visit thee?' And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me.'
