We know that in everything God works for good with those who love him, who are called according to his purpose. Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed are you, Virgin Mary and most worthy of all praise: for the Sun of Justice, Christ our God, was born of you.. Alleluia!

# Christ's Presence in the words of the Gospel may be honoured with incense.

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Matthew. Glory be to Thee, O Lord.

The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. Abraham was the father of Isaac, and Isaac the father of Jacob, and Jacob the father of Judah and his brothers, and Judah the father of Perez and Zerah by Tamar, and Perez the father of Hezron, and Hezron the father of Ram, and Ram the father of Ammin'adab, and Ammin'adab the father of Nahshon, and Nahshon the father of Salmon, and Salmon the father of Bo'az by Rahab, and Bo'az the father of Obed by Ruth, and Obed the father of Jesse, and Jesse the father of David the king. And David was the father of Solomon by the wife of Uri'ah, and Solomon the father of Rehobo'am, and Rehobo'am the father of Abi'jah, and Abi'jah the father of Asa, and Asa the father of Jehosh'aphat, and Jehosh'aphat the father of Joram, and Joram the father of Uzzi'ah, and Uzzi'ah the father of Jotham, and Jotham the father of Ahaz, and Ahaz the father of Hezeki'ah, and Hezeki'ah the father of Manas'seh, and Manas'seh the father of Amos, and Amos the father of Josi'ah, and Josi'ah the father of Jechoniah and his brothers, at the time of the deportation to Babylon. And after the deportation to Babylon: Jechoni'ah was the father of She-al'ti-el, and She-al'ti-el the father of Zerub'babel, and Zerub'babel the father of Abi'ud, and Abi'ud the father of Eli'akim, and Eli'akim the father of Azor, and Azor the father of Zadok, and Zadok the father of Achim, and Achim the father of Eli'ud. and Eli'ud the father of Elea'zar, and Elea'zar the father of Matthan, and Matthan the father of Jacob, and Jacob the father of Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ. Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child of the Holy Spirit; and her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly.

But as he considered this, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit; she will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfil what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and his name shall be called Emmanuel" (which means, God with us).

This is the Gospel of the Lord. Praise be to Thee, O Christ.

## A homily may follow.

As Mary obeyed God's will for her to become the Mother of His Son; so let us turn in obedience to Him and lay before Him the needs of the world and the Church:

Your prophet of old foretold a day when a virgin would conceive and bear a son who would be called God-with-us: help us to look forward to Your deliverance and seek the fullness of Your Kingdom: Lord, hear us ... Lord, graciously hear us.

Your angel declared to Mary that she was to the Mother of the Saviour: help every Christian person to be open to Your Word and obedient to Your will: Lord, hear us ... Lord, graciously hear us.

Mary bore a Son of David's line, born a King Whose reign would never end: bless all the nations of the world with Christ's gift of peace: Lord, hear us ... Lord, graciously hear us.

The Child Jesus grew in wisdom and stature in the home of Mary and Joseph: strengthen our homes and families and keep under Your protection all whom we love: Lord, hear us ... Lord, graciously hear us.

In the motherhood of Mary, many find strength and inspiration: guide and strengthen the work of the Mothers' Union throughout the world: Lord, hear us ... Lord, graciously hear us.

At the foot of the Cross stood His Mother, and from the Cross she received his lifeless Body in her arms: give comfort and healing to all who suffer and all who watch the suffering of those they love: Lord, hear us ... Lord, graciously hear us.

As he held Christ in his arms, Simeon warned Mary that a sword would pierce her soul. Enfold in Your love all who endure abuse and anguish and give them hope: Lord, hear us ... Lord, graciously hear us.

The Apostle John saw a vision of a woman in Heaven, robed with the sun: bring us will all who have died to share the joy of Heaven with our Lady and all the saints: Lord, hear us ... Lord, graciously hear us.

In union with our Lady, Saint Matthew, Saint Philip, Saint Augustine, Saint Anne, Saint Joachim and all the saints, we pray that the whole world may come to praise and magnify God's holy Name, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Amen.

God has set His sanctuary in our midst for evermore; and established a covenant of peace.

The Peace of the Lord be always with you.

And with thy spirit.

As the bread and wine are brought to the Altar and prepared for the Mass, the following is sung:

My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; and my spirit exults in God my Saviour.

Here, while the Cherubim within the veil, adore the blest, life-giving Trinity, we in earth's worship echoing their part, hymn the thrice-holy in their company. So let all earthly cares be laid aside, that we may welcome Him Who draweth nigh, the King of Glory entering His courts, girt by the hidden armies of the sky. Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia!

- 1. Ye who own the Faith of Jesus Sing the wonders that were done, When the love of God the Father O'er our sin the vict'ry won, When He made the Virgin Mary Mother of His only Son.

## The priest begins the great prayer of thanksgiving:

The Lord be with you.

And with thy spirit.

Lift up your hearts;

We lift them up unto the Lord.

Let us give thanks unto our Lord God.

It is meet and right so to do.

Father, all powerful and ever-living God,
We do well always to give You thanks
As we celebrate the Birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
In choosing her to be the Mother of Your Son
You have exalted the humble and meek.
Your angel hailed her as the most highly favoured;
With all generations we call her blessed
And with her we rejoice and magnify Your holy Name.
Therefore we bled our voices with the choirs of angels
And all the powers of Heaven
For ever praising You and saying.

Holy, holy, Lord God of hosts. Heaven and earth are full of Thy glory. Glory be to Thee, O Lord most high.

+ Blessed is He that cometh in the Name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

We praise and bless you, loving Father, through Jesus Christ, our Lord; and as we obey his command, send your Holy Spirit, that broken bread and wine outpoured may be for us the body and blood of your dear Son.

On the night before he died he had supper with his Apostles and, taking bread, he praised you. He broke the bread, gave it to them and said: Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me.

## The priest holds up the consecrated Host for the people to see.

When supper was ended he took the cup of wine.

Again he praised you, gave it to them and said:

Drink this, all of you;
this is my blood of the new covenant,
which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins.

Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.

The priest holds up the chalice of consecrated wine for the people to see.

So, Father, we remember all that Jesus did, in him we plead with confidence his sacrifice made once for all upon the cross.

Bringing before you the bread of life and cup of salvation, we proclaim his death and resurrection until he comes in glory.

Christ has died; Christ is risen; Christ will come again.

Lord of all life, help us to work together for that day when your kingdom comes and justice and mercy will be seen in all the earth. Look with favour on your people, gather us in your loving arms and bring us with [N and] all the saints to feast at your table in heaven.

Through Jesus Christ, our Lord, By Whom and with Whom and in Whom, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honour and glory are yours, O loving Father, for ever and ever.

Instructed by saving precepts and taught by divine example, we are bold to say:

Our Father,
Who art in Heaven,
hallowed by Thy Name;
Thy Kingdom come,
Thy Will be done on earth as it is in Heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread
and forgive us our trespasses
as we forgive those who trespass against us;
and lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.

We break this bread to share in the Body of Christ. Though we are many, we are one body, because we all share in one bread. O Lamb of God, that takest away the sins of the world, have mercy upon us. The priest holds up the consecrated elements and invites people to receive Holy Communion:

+ Behold the Lamb of God; behold Him, Who takes away the sin of the world; happy are they who are called to His Supper.

#### Holy Communion follows.
